

RULES AND SCHEDULE OF ELECTION OF REGISTERED GRADUATES OF IBA

Under the Institute of Business Administration Act, 1994 (Sindh Act No. XX of 1994, PART – IV (I) (xiii), the Board of Governors of the Institute of Business Administration consists of, among others, one member of the Registered Graduates of the Institute elected from amongst themselves.

The election of the representative of the Registered Graduates on IBA Board of Governors will be held on Saturday July 4, 2009 at the IBA City Campus, Garden / Kiyani Shaheed Road, Karachi, according to the procedure given below:

Procedure of Election

1. The first list of the Registered Graduates will be posted on the IBA Website on May 27, 2009.
2. Objections/claims in writing can be submitted to the Registrar, IBA from May 28 – 30, 2009 (on working days) between 3:00 to 6:00 p.m. (Friday 5:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.). The objections / claims received will be considered by an Election Committee. The Committee's decision will be final.
3. The final list of the Registered Graduates will be posted on the IBA website at 5:00 p.m. on June 5, 2009.
4. Nomination on prescribed form shall be made between June 8 – 12, 2009 from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. on working days (Friday 5:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.). Forms for nomination can be obtained from the IBA, City Campus from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Nomination Form can also be downloaded from IBA Website.
5. The first list of candidates will be posted on the IBA Website on June 16, 2009 by 4:00 p.m.
6. A candidature can be withdrawn by the candidate concerned on or before June 23, 2009 upto 5:00 p.m.
7. The final list of candidates shall be posted on IBA Website / Notice Board of the IBA City Campus on June 23, 2009 by 7:30 p.m.
8. Every nomination must be made by a proposer and seconder who must be registered graduate entitled to vote in the election of the representative of the Registered Graduates on the Board of Governors of the IBA, and the proposal must have the written consent of the person proposed.
9. The election will be through secret ballot.
10. The election shall be held on the system of simple majority vote. In case of tie, the election will be decided by a lot drawn by the Returning Officer in the presence of the candidates or their agents.

11. Every voter shall be entitled to cast one vote and no voter shall cast more than one vote.
12. Mr. Ahmed Zaheer, Registrar, IBA, will act as Returning Officer in the election.
13. Each candidate can post one agent in the polling room.
14. Each candidate or his/her agent can be present at the time of counting of votes.
15. Counting will take place at 8:30 p.m. on July 4, 2009 and the result will be announced immediately thereafter.
16. All disputes arising out of the election will be refereed to the Director, IBA, whose decision will be final.
17. In case of change in the person of voter (nominated, elected or ex-officio) after the notification of the date of election but prior to polls, the voters list already notified shall continue to hold good and the changed person shall be deemed to have been included in it at the time of its notification.
18. All Registered Graduates are requested to bring their Computerized National Identification Card for identification to cast their votes.
