



Executive Director IBA visited Chitral as part of NTHP's Outreach activities

November 20-24: Dr. S Akbar Zaidi, Executive Director, IBA Karachi, visited Lower Chitral (Susum, Royee, Garamchashma) and Upper Chitral (Kuragh, Booni, Parwak, Chapali) regions, as part of National Talent Hunt Program (NTHP) to invite potential candidates to apply for the IBA NTHP - Batch 2024, which is a fully funded scholarship program. The THP team, along with Dr. Zaidi, toured various schools and colleges and met with students from multiple institutions.



Green initiatives at IBA

IBA is dedicated to reducing the institution's carbon footprint through sustainable initiatives. Our noteworthy accomplishments include the implementation of the Reverse Osmosis (RO) Plant, known as 'H2GO,' and the successful completion of On-Grid Solar Energy projects.

The 'H2GO' RO Plant at the Main Campus has a capacity of producing 5000 gallons of treated drinking water daily. This vital resource is distributed strategically across the campus and hostels, resulting in significant carbon savings and responsibly meeting the hydration needs of our community.

Simultaneously, our completed 826 kWP On-Grid Solar Energy Project at the Main Campus, achieves a 15% annual reduction in electricity bills. The synergy with the 100 kWP On-Grid Solar Energy Project at the Girls Hostels results in a total capacity of 926 kWP, estimated to generate 1.235 million units of electricity annually. These achievements underscore IBA's unwavering dedication to sustainable practices.

The institution is consistently identifying new locations for solar panels to expand energy generation capacity. This initiative aligns with our goal to significantly reduce dependence on conventional energy sources, thereby minimizing our overall carbon footprint.

IBA Convocation 2023 - 1,184 degrees conferred

First cohort of MS Finance Program graduated

December 02: IBA held its convocation for the Class of 2023 at the Main Campus. It marked a momentous occasion as 1,184 graduates were conferred degrees in several disciplines. The graduating batch included 776 graduates from six undergraduate programs, 403 graduates from ten postgraduate programs, and five graduates from 3 PhD programs. The Chief Guest of the ceremony was Caretaker Chief Minister of Sindh and Patron IBA, Justice (Retd.) Magbool Bagar. Dr. Azra Raza, Chan Soon-Shiong Professor of Medicine and Clinical Director, Edward P. Evans Foundation MDS Center, Columbia University in New York attended as Guest of Honor.

School of Mathematics and Computer Science (SMCS)


Game Jam 2023

'The Future of Pakistan's Economy' - Forum hosted by IBA organized by Daily Jang




